

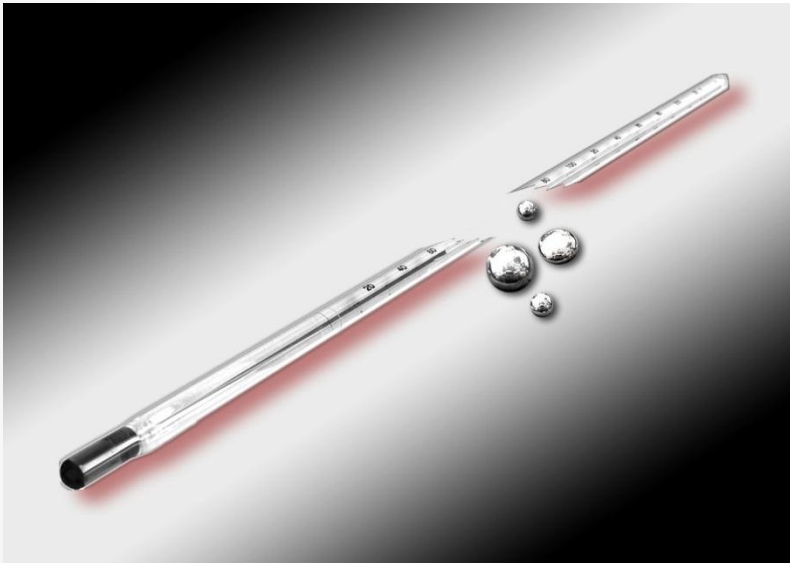

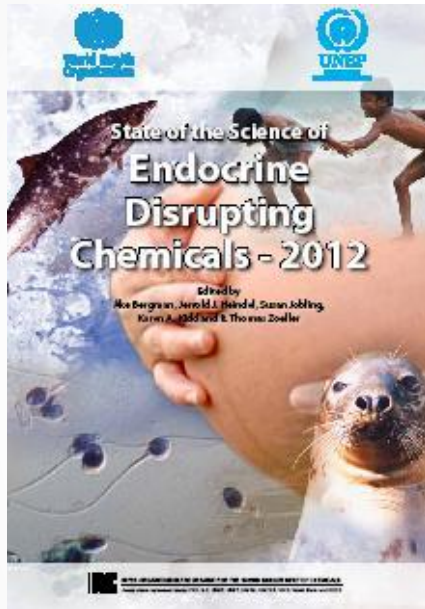


The Minamata Convention, a new global agreement that will ban mercury from most uses by 2020.

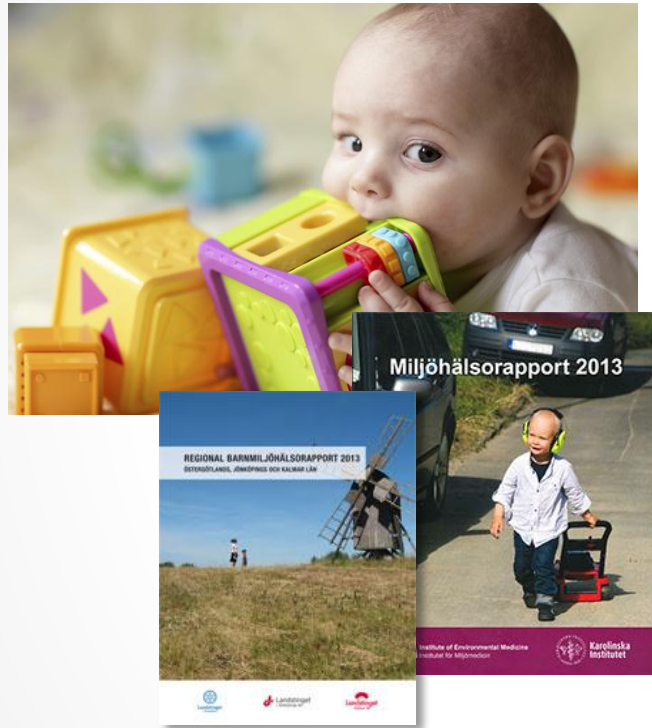


WHO/UNEP State of the science report on EDC, an emerging issue

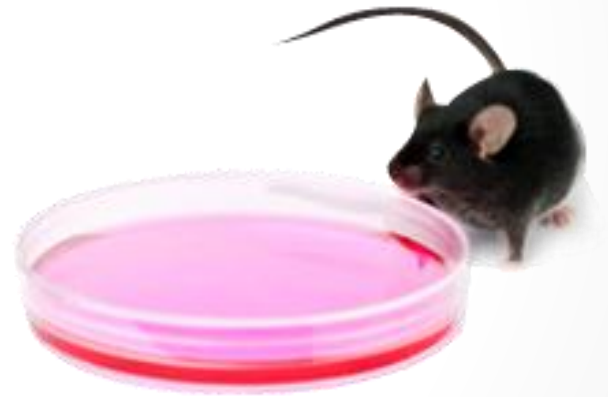
