

Instructions for abstract submissions

Abstract for potential oral presentation – deadline 28 February

You submit your abstract via the [abstract submission form](#).

Please provide the full title (word limit of 50 words) and paste in the abstract. The body of the abstract should not be longer than 250 words and must contain the following: rationale and scope of the study, brief description of the experimental procedures, results and conclusion(s). Do not include headers, tables, figures, references or chemical structures.

Fill in all authors and their respective affiliations in the order that you wish them to appear in printed the program.

In the drop-down menu under *Presentation*, please choose the option *Oral* to undergo review for oral presentation. If you choose the option *Either*, the abstract will also be reviewed for poster presentation in the case it is not selected for oral presentation.

In the drop-down menu under *Category – topic*, assign your abstract to the suitable session topic (1-4).

You will be notified by email on the result of the review in mid-March and get further instructions from the organizers.

Abstract for poster presentation – deadline 31 March

You submit your abstract via the [abstract submission form](#).

Please provide the full title (word limit of 50 words) and paste in the abstract. The body of the abstract should not be longer than 250 words and must contain the following: rationale and scope of the study, brief description of the experimental procedures, results and conclusion(s). Do not include headers, tables, figures, references or chemical structures.

Fill in all authors and their respective affiliations in the order that you wish them to appear in printed the program.

In the drop-down menu under *Presentation*, please choose the option *Poster* to undergo review for poster presentation.

In the drop-down menu under *Category – topic*, assign your abstract to the suitable session topic (1-4) or you choose the *Other* (5). Abstracts for poster presentations are not limited to the theme of the NorthTox meeting. Poster presentations within all field of toxicology are welcome.

You will be notified by email on the result of the review in the beginning of April and get further instructions from the organizers.

Poster presentation award

Everyone is welcome to submit an abstract and present a poster at NorthTox, but only Master and PhD students can compete for the poster presentation award. During the poster presentation sessions, the poster award committee will interact with the students that compete for the prize.

One up to 3 students will be awarded and share the honor and prize money. The selected winners should also be prepared to give a 3 min presentation (based on the submitted pdf-file of the poster) in connection to the presentation of the winner(s) of the poster presentation award at the closure of the NorthTox meeting. ***To participate in the competition for the poster presentation award you also have to submit your poster in pdf-format (max 10 MB).***
