## HOW TO DEAL WITH RISKS AND BENEFITS

### Abstract submission & Poster presentation

The ***abstract should be submitted no later than April 19***. The topic is not limited to the theme of the annual meeting. Abstracts and poster presentations within all fields of toxicology are welcome.

The abstract should include a title, author list, and institutions. The body of the abstract should not be longer than 200 words and must contain the following: rationale and scope of the study, brief description of the experimental procedures, results and conclusion(s). Do not include headers, tables, figures, references or chemical structures.

All posters should be presented during the lunch session on the annual meeting April 29 at Stockholm University (De Geersalen, Geohuset). The poster should be printed and presented in a portrait-oriented format, max 80x140 cm (WxH). The poster should clearly describe what was done and found, and include all authors and institutions. Master and PhD students that present a poster will get a 50% discount on the dinner at the Swedish Museum of Natural History. However, ***to get the discount and compete in the poster presentation award***, you must also ***submit your poster as a pdf no later than April 19***. ### Poster presentation award

Everyone is welcome to submit an abstract and present a poster at the annual meeting, but only Master and PhD students can compete for the poster presentation award. During the lunch poster presentation session, the poster award committee will interact with the students that compete for the prize. One up to 3 students will be awarded and share the honor and prize money. The selected winners should also give a 3 min presentation (based on the submitted pdf-file of the poster) in the end of the annual meeting.
