

## Instructions for posters

NorthTox Stockholm 20-21 April 2023

### Abstract for poster presentation – deadline 31 March

You submit your abstract via the [abstract submission form](#).

Please provide the full title (word limit of 50 words) and paste in the abstract. The body of the abstract should not be longer than 250 words and must contain the following: rationale and scope of the study, brief description of the experimental procedures, results and conclusion(s). Do not include headers, tables, figures, references or chemical structures.

Fill in all authors and their respective affiliations in the order that you wish them to appear in printed the program.

In the drop-down menu under *Presentation*, please choose the option *Poster* to undergo review for poster presentation.

In the drop-down menu under *Category – topic*, assign your abstract to the suitable session topic (1-4) or you choose the *Other* (5). Abstracts for poster presentations are not limited to the theme of the NorthTox meeting. **Poster presentations within all field of toxicology are welcome.**

You will be notified by email on the result of the review in the beginning of April and get further instructions from the organizers.

### Preparing and presenting the poster

Accepted posters should be presented during the main NorthTox poster session (for more details regarding time etc., see information on the program) as well as during coffee, and lunch breaks.

There will be a separate space assigned for posters outside of the Aula Magna meeting room. **The poster should be printed and presented in a portrait-oriented format, max 80x140 cm (WxH)**. The poster should clearly describe what was done and found, and include all authors and institutions.

### Poster presentation award

Everyone is welcome to submit an abstract and present a poster at NorthTox, but only Master and PhD students can compete for the poster presentation award. During the poster presentation sessions, the poster award committee will interact with the students that compete for the prize. One up to 3 students will be awarded and share the honor and prize money. The selected winners should also be prepared to give a 3 min presentation (based on the submitted pdf-file of the poster) in connection to the presentation of the winner(s) of the poster presentation award at the closure of the NorthTox meeting. ***To participate in the competition for the poster presentation award you also have to submit your poster in pdf-format (max 10 MB) by March 31<sup>st</sup>.***
